- I. Review, discussion and possible approval of proposed projects for application for CDBG funding to be posted for public comment, and all related matters. (Action Item)**
1. Mayor Cliff Eklund explained there is a list of proposed projects and some may not meet the requirements of the median income and therefore not qualify for CDBG grants.
 2. City Manager Glenn Trust reported the list will be posted for 14 days for public comments and brought back to the next Council meeting for the members to choose two (2) projects,
 3. Vice Mayor Donnetta Skinner stated the Tomera Project has been on the list for a while and they are no closer to getting it done and she believes it should not be on the list.
 4. Councilperson David Trujillo inquired if there was any reason to consider the four (4) projects that may not adhere to the requirements.
 5. City Manager Glenn Trust stated they can always be considered, but are on the list due to City Staff requests. He stated that if they target the low to moderate income population on them and show that they meet the requirements, they might be considered. He stated blight or urgent need projects are included, which can have ramifications. He stated they can spot blight and he would recommend using the spot blight classification.
 6. **Vice Mayor Donnetta Skinner moved for approval of proposed projects for application for CDBG funding to be posted for public comment, and all related matters. Councilperson Lincoln Litchfield seconded the motion. The motion carried.**
