Call to Order and Roll Call

Mayor Cliff Eklund stated the sole purpose for this meeting is to canvass the votes in the election of November 2, 2010, and declaration of the results pursuant to Carlin City Code 1-5-1, Article V, Section 5.090, and all matters related thereto. The City Charter requires the City Council to canvass the election votes and declare a result. The Council should review the numbers of votes and assure that they were recorded properly or determine if there is any reason to question the results. If the Council is assured that the vote count and process was proper and accurate they then declare the winners in all races. The City Clerk is required to keep the vote results secure until they are canvassed by the City Council. Her official results will be available at the meeting. The unofficial summary of the results is as follows:

Cliff Eklund	270 votes/ 54.44%
Lincoln Litchfield	226 votes/ 45.56%

City Council

Donnetta Skinner	344 votes/ 38.78%
Steve Feasel	328 votes/ 36.98%
David Trujillo	215 votes/ 24.24%

If there is no objection or questions to the results I will entertain a motion to approve the canvass of votes of the November 2, 2010, election.

Vice Mayor Donnetta Skinner made a motion to declare the results of the election as follows:

**Cliff Eklund elected to a four year term as Mayor
Donnetta Skinner elected to a four year term on the City Council
Steve Feasel elected to a four year term on the City Council**

With all terms and official duties beginning on January 3, 2011. Councilperson Lincoln Litchfield seconded the motion. The motion carried.
